







Color legend:


No restrictions

Full restrictions








Communication Activities during Covid-19 Epidemic



- Informing target public about changes in activities of the programme during covid-19 via Svit website and call center:
 - participation in the programme is safe
 - individuals can submit FIT samples to the mailbox and not only at the post office counter
 - certificates issued for crossing municipalities and regions during inland travel ban,....
- Joint communication of all three organized cancer screening programms;
- Communication Campaign "Take Care of Your Ass";
- Intense collaboration between colonoscopy centres and programme coordination team secured an intense restart and catch-up.
