

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





STRATEGIES TO MITIGATE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

COLONOSCOPIC SURVEILLANCE FOLLOWING INTERMEDIATE AND HIGH RISK ADENOMA





STEPS FORWARD

- Recover the delay in invitations in 2022 90% invited < 30 months
- Recover the participation rate in 2021 to prepandemic period including the following five waves (72.5% in 2018 to 72% 2021)
- Monitoring all CRC due to the delay in invitations ≠ Interval Cancer FIT
 - Interval Cancer FIT (monitored from 2009) steady
 - Postcolonoscopy (non Interval Type B) could increase middle-long term*
 - CRC because of delay in invitations (FIT > 30 months)*
